Twitter is an online social networking service that enables users to send and read short 140-character messages called "tweets".

@usmccca = twitter address

#usmccca = Hashtags make it possible to group such messages, since you can search for the hashtag and get the set of messages that contain it. For example, any tweet that contains #usmccca will be gathered into one feed.

Pinterest Is described by its creators as a visual discovery tool. People use Pinterest to collect ideas for projects and interests. Users create and share collections (called "boards") of visual bookmarks (called "Pins") that they use to do things like plan trips, develop projects, organize events or save articles and recipes and creative ideas.

Instagram is an online mobile photo-sharing, video-sharing and social networking service that enables its users to take pictures and videos, and share them on a variety of social networking platforms, such as Facebook, Twitter, Tumblr and Flickr. A distinctive feature is that it confines photos to a square shape, similar to Kodak Instamatic and Polaroid images, in contrast to the 4:3 aspect ratio typically used by mobile device cameras.

LinkedIn is a business-oriented social networking service. The basic functionality of LinkedIn allows users (workers and employers) to create profiles and "connections" to each other in an online social network which may represent real-world professional relationships. Users can invite anyone (whether a site user or not) to become a connection. However, if the invitee selects "I don't know" or "Spam", this counts against the inviter. If the inviter gets too many of such responses, the account may be restricted or closed.
