

L.A. Chapter Still Active

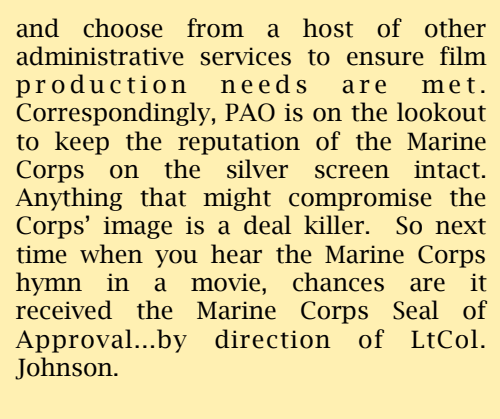
